	Plan B	<u>Crew close to clubhouse in cold water</u> Follow capsiz drill. Leave boat on bank if concerns about hypothermia. Return to club house if possible. Organise recovery. Contact help if required	
	Plan C	<u>Crew remote from clubhouse in cold weather</u> Follow capsiz drills. Leave boat on bank if concerned about hypothermia. Use methods to keep warm. Wait on bank, organise help/recovery if required.
